Elaborating on the system, Rajesh Banerjee, Director of Pinnacle Teleservices informed that the schools do not have to invest much in deploying this system as the RFID, photo ID cards for students are provided by the organization and students would not have to carry two

different identity cards. The charges per month for parents, who are availing this services are also very economical making it a must have product for all schools. It's a very innovative futuristic product that will help in bridging the gap between the modern urban parents and the educational institutes, said Banerjee. He further informed that the moment the child enters the school the parents will be informed that their ward has reached the school safely and similarly the moment the child leaves the school the parents will get a message on the mobile regarding the same.
