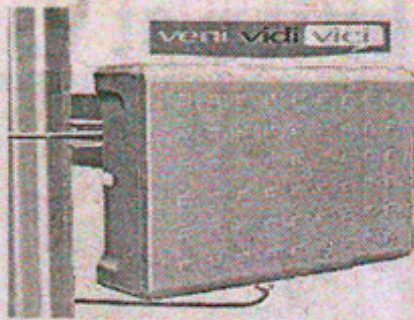

RIFD System in Navi Mumbai

VASHI: Vini Vidi Vici – the firm behind the unique initiative of RFID (Radio Frequency Identification Device) is overwhelmed with the response of the schools from Navi Mumbai. Green Fingers Global School, Kharghar installed RFID in the school to help parents keep a check on their children. The device will send messages to parents once their kids enter or leave the school premises. A chip will be installed into the identity card of the students and a RFI reader will detect the I-cards which will then send a SMS to the parents. Mobile number of parents will be stored in a school computer which will be accessed by the Device. NEWSBAND had earlier reported about the system

which helps Mumbai based schools to keep a watch on their students and would soon be launched in Navi Mumbai. By installing the device, Green Fingers School, Kharghar leaves a trail of perfect example for others to follow. The system will give updates of students' whereabouts to parents. It will also help teachers to get rid of the manual roll call system. Moreover, other details like holidays, PTA meetings and students' programmes can also be messaged to parents through the device. Vinita Gambhir, Principal, Green Fingers Global School said, "Today most of the parents are working specially the mothers, as a result of which tracking kids is difficult, thus this device proves to be a boon to them and they are really happy." Vini Vidi Vici has also plans to install other services like vehicle tracking system and library management system in the future. "Navi Mumbai has almost 80% of working women, so this device proves to be good to them. We have got good response from many schools in the city," said Kapil Mathur from Vini Vidi Vici.
